<p>Used household goods and personal effects. - foreign citizens coming temporarily to Czech Republic.</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • photocopy of residency permit. • photocopy of housing contract (the rental period has to be for minimum of 24 months). • photocopy of passport • the importer's employer is required to write on a letterhead paper, a guarantee of paying the customs duties on the importer's belongings in case of non-re-exportation. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ power of attorney to authorise the removal agent to represent the importer with the customs authorities. ○ inventory list with total value of the shipment, the serial number of any electrical appliances, specification and photos of any antique items and valuable paintings. 	<p>Duty free, subject of re-exportation.</p>	<p>In case the client did not apply for the residency permit or he does not have the housing contract yet, the customs authorities request a deposit of 50% of the total value of the shipment. It can be paid in cash or replaced by a guarantee letter from a bank. The deposit is returned after presenting the residency permit and housing contract.</p> <p>Please note that the customs authorities can request the deposit even in case the client has all the requested documents (it depends on the residential district). The deposit is returned after re-exporting the goods from Czech Republic.</p> <p>Please note that these goods are admitted as duty free only temporarily.</p>

Automobiles + motorcycles	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • original invoice or purchasing contract. • car title and technical book of the car • the importer's employer is required to write on a letter head paper, a guarantee of paying the customs duties on the car in case of non-re-exportation. • power of attorney to authorise the removal agent to represent the importer with the customs authorities. • photocopy of residency permit. • photocopy of housing contract (the rental period has to be for minimum of 24 months). • photocopy of passport. 	Duty free, subject of re-exportation.	<p>During temporary importation period the car must not be sold.</p> <p>The car should not be older than 10 years and younger than 6 months.</p>

Alcohol and cigarettes	as for removal household goods and personal effects.	Duty free (as a part of shipment with used household goods).	<p>Maximum quantity allowed to be imported :</p> <p>2 litres of wine 1 litre of hard drink 200 cigarettes or 250 grams of tobacco.</p>

Animals	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • veterinary import permission issued by state vet office in Prague, Czech Republic. • veterinary certificate issued by the state vet office in the country of the animal origin. • international vaccination certificate. 	Duty free (as a part of shipment with used household goods).	
Arms	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • document issued by the Embassy of Czech Republic in the country the client lives. 	Duty free (as a part of shipment with used household goods)	After the customs clearance in Czech Republic the arms have to be given over to a police department until the client will get the Czech fire-arms licence.
